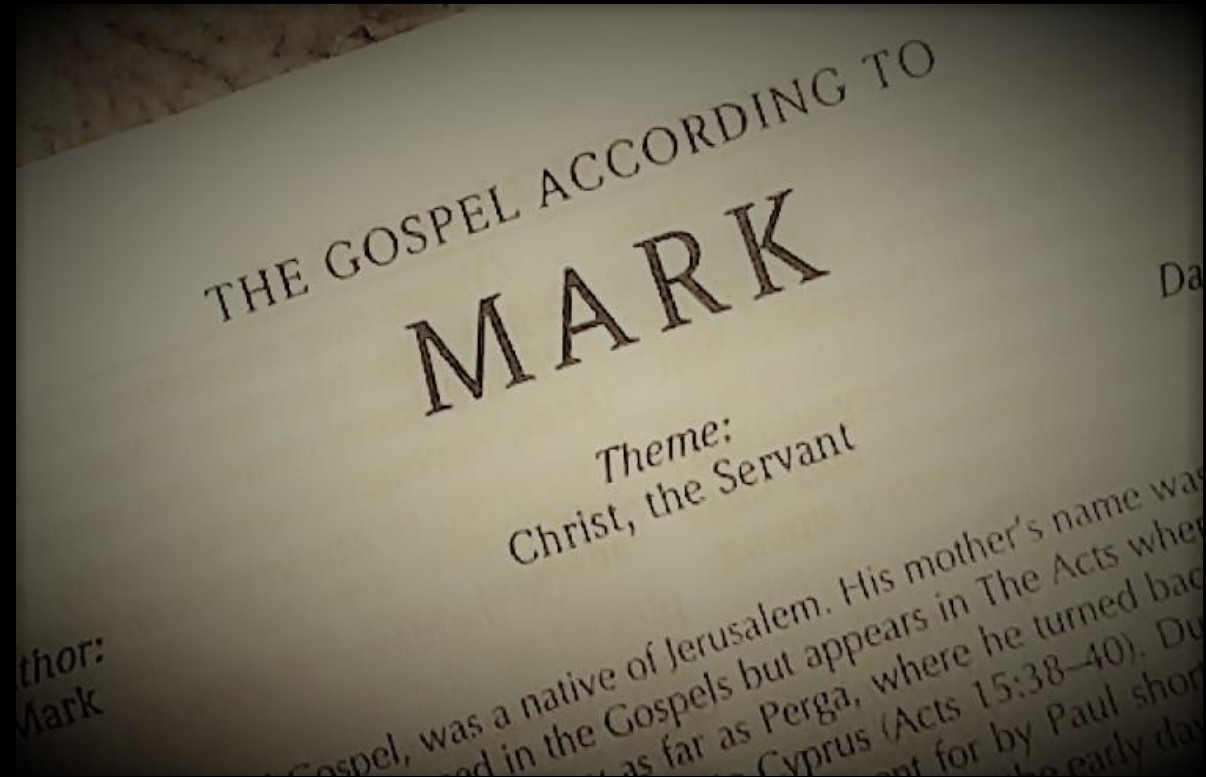

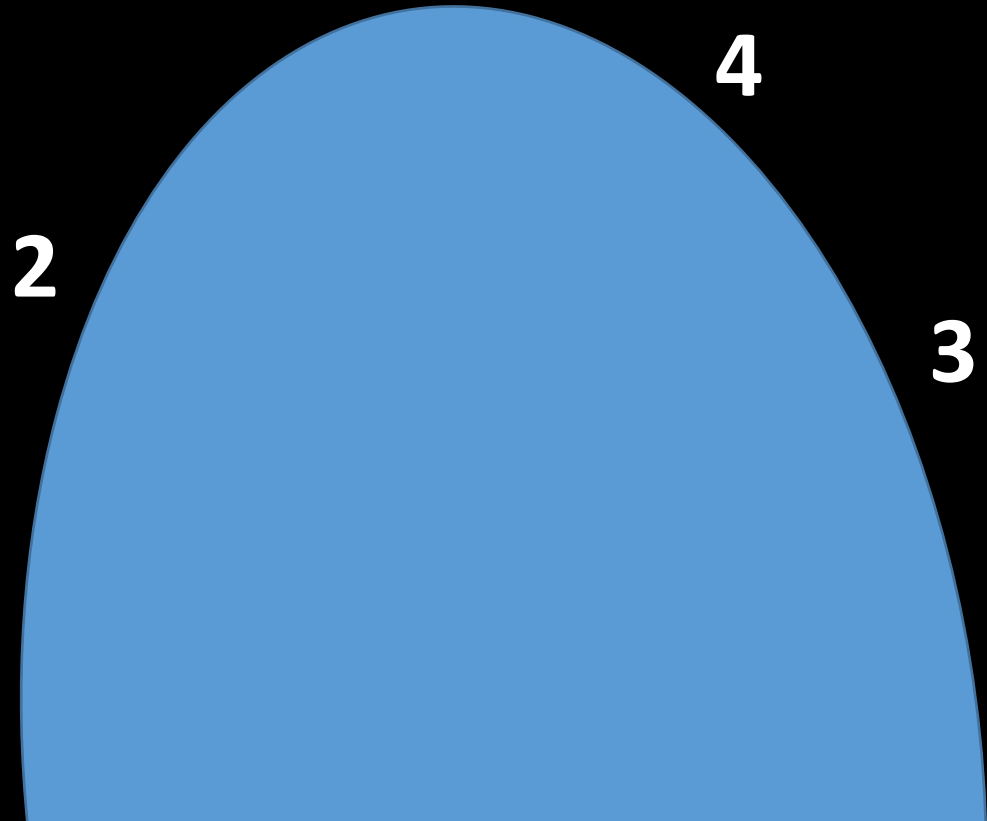

“With Peter’s declaration at Caesarea Philippi, Mark’s story of Jesus reaches a denouement. Hereto the disciples, like the crowds and especially the religious leaders of the Pharisees and scribes, have been ranged against Jesus on a scale from misunderstanding to opposition. They have been slow of understanding and hard of heart. Responses of faithfulness to Jesus have been few and sporadic, and when faithfulness has been found, it has surprisingly come from ‘outsiders’ – from an unclean woman (5:25-34), a Syrophenician woman (7:24-30), and a Gentile deaf-mute (7:31-37).

Declarations of Jesus' true identity as God's Son have been given by Mark as narrator (1:1), by God (1:9-11), and by demons (1:25; 3:11; 5:7), but not yet by humans. Caesarea Philippi is the first breakthrough in the human plot of the Gospel."

Jesus **reveals**: opening blind beggar's eyes

Setting (8:22)

Stage 1 – Partial Vision “I see trees” (8:23-24)

Stage 2 – Full Vision “restored,” “saw clearly” (8:25)

Jesus **conceals**: Warning “Don't go to village” (8:26)

Jesus **reveals** : opening disciples'/Peter's eyes

Stage 1 – Messiah (8:27-29)

Jesus **conceals**: Warning “Don't tell anyone” (8:30)

Stage 2– Suffering, Death, Resurrection, “clearly” (8:31-32a)

Peter **rebukes** Jesus (8:32b)

Jesus **rebukes** Peter: Warning “Get behind me” (8:33)

Jesus **reveals** : the path of discipleship: the cross (8:34-38)

Jesus **reveals** : disciples will see kingdom in power (9:1)
