

1. Jesus Transfigured 9:2-13

- Jesus led them up the mountain.
- Transfigured means transformed
- If we're not careful, we think of the transfiguration as just a bright light shined on Jesus. But this wasn't a light coming on Jesus from the outside. "The word *transfigured* describes a change on the outside that comes from the inside. It is the opposite of 'masquerade,' which is an outward change that does not come from within." (Wiersbe)

1. Jesus Transfigured 9:2-13

- God does not cover us up He makes us new.

Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new 2Cor 5:17

The Elijah who has come is John the Baptist

1. Jesus Transfigured 9:2-13

- *The suffering Jesus had to endure was that of the cross.*

- ...They pierced My hands and My feet; I can count all My bones. They look *and* stare at Me. They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots. Psalm 22:16-18

- Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons

- It is not a question of God's ability to heal or deliver us.
- But Jesus looked at *them* and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." Matthew 19:26
- The Lord said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh and say, 'Shall I indeed bear a child, now that I am old?' Is anything too hard for the Lord? Genesis 18:13-14

- *The disciples did not understand*

- *Jesus was/is servant of all*
